



Directions to the BBC Media Village

Please note that to access any of our buildings you will need to obtain a security pass and be collected by a BBC Worldwide member of staff from the Media Centre reception.

To help reduce our environmental impact **we encourage staff and visitors coming to the Media Village to walk, cycle or use public transport**. Details are given below on the London Underground and Overground as well as bus routes, facilities for cyclists and details of the shuttle bus service for BBC staff. Directions for driving to the Media Village can also be found below but please note that visitor car parking spaces are very limited and must be booked in advance.



The closest Underground station to the Media Village is **White City (central line)**.

Once you alight from the station, cross over the road at the pedestrian crossing and turn right. Continue up Wood Lane until you reach another pedestrian crossing. Cross here and directly in front of you will be the Media Village.

Follow the path up towards the centre of the complex and the Media Centre will be on your left. The main entrance is situated between Mangiare cafe and Davy's wine bar.

There have been some new developments on the Underground network close to our location which may benefit you when travelling to the Media Village:

- 'Wood Lane' underground station (**Hammersmith & City line**) has now opened
- A fully accessible **Overground** and National Rail station is now open at **Shepherd's Bush** on the Willesden Junction to Clapham Junction line.

Buses

Buses currently serving Wood Lane are **72, N72, 95** and **220**.

A fully accessible bus station, **White City bus station**, is due to open next to the new 'Wood Lane' underground station in late November 2008.



Cycle facilities



Secure bicycle parking is available in the underground car park which is located below the Broadcast Centre and the Media Centre. Please note that your BBC staff pass must be updated with the correct access. If you find you do not have access please arrange this via the ID Unit on (02)81333, e-mail 'ID Unit – Media Village'.

There are 570 bicycle parking spaces located as follows:

Underground car park – 380

The Network – 64

North Cross Street – 112

Outside perimeter buildings – 14

An additional 50+ bicycle parking spaces will be issued to us over the next few months.

There are over 400 **lockers** of various sizes located inside the cycle enclosure in the basement. Padlocks are available from Floor Managers. Lockers are available on a first-come basis – lockers that have been locked when empty will have the lock removed to allow others to use it, so please take your lock with you when you empty a locker.

Showers can be found on each floor of the Media Centre, one in each toilet core. There are also showers in the Garden House, the Lighthouse, the Broadcast Centre and the White City building.

In addition, there are parking facilities for motorcycles in the basement.

BBC shuttle bus



There is a shuttle bus service operating between the main BBC sites in London. This service is free and your pass must be presented when you board the bus.

The shuttle bus stop for the Media Village is located outside the front of the White City Building.

Driving

Wood Lane runs between the A40 (Westway) and Shepherd's Bush Green. If arriving via the A40, you should leave at the White City flyover.

Shepherd's Bush Green is a gyratory connecting Goldhawk Road (A402 - Chiswick), Uxbridge Road (A4020 - Acton/Ealing), Shepherd's Bush Road (A219 - Hammersmith & A4) and Holland Park Avenue (A40 - Central London).

To get to the Media Village car parking, you must drive into South Africa Road and then turn right into White City Road (aka Dorando Close), continue to the very end and you will see the BBC security. **You will not be able to park here unless a space has already been booked for you by the BBC staff member that you are visiting.**
